

WINTERIZING YOUR HOME CHECKLIST

Prepare Your Roof For Winter Weather

- **Clean Gutters and Downspouts:** Remove debris to prevent ice dams, which can cause water to back up and leak into the roof.
- Schedule a Professional Roof Inspection: Have a professional inspect your roof to identify any weaknesses or areas of concern before the harsh winter weather.

Ensure Your Attic is Properly Insulated and Ventilated

- Add Insulation: Make sure the attic is properly insulated to help prevent heat loss, which can cause snow to melt and refreeze as ice dams.
